This registration form is a legal document. The student registration form is used to enroll a student who is new to Northland School Division, who is returning to the division, or who is transferring to a school within the division. The registration form is also used annually to record important changes, such as student legal name, citizenship, residency information, legal relationship of parent/guardian to student, health information disclosure, Francophone Education rights, independent student status, or self-declaration of Aboriginal ancestry. A student cannot be registered without a copy of a legal document (birth certificate, permanent residency document, Canadian citizenship document, or passport) that provides proof of legal name and age.
