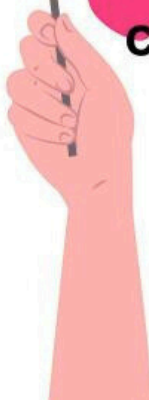


In June we take the time to honor the rich history, heritage, resilience, diversity and significant contributions of the First Nations, Inuit, and Metis peoples.
